MATC FALL SPORTS EXPERIENCE TREMENDOUS SUCCESS

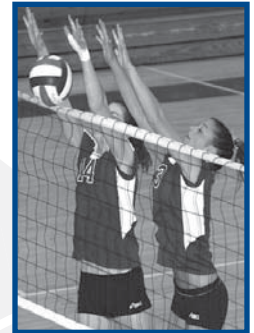
The WolfPack Athletic teams experienced tremendous success during the fall season. The MATC Golf, Soccer and Women's Volleyball teams swept their way through state competition as all three teams won conference and state titles. On national and regional levels, all three teams experienced similar success as well.

The MATC Volleyball team, ranked #3 in the nation in the final NJCAA poll, faced Ridgewater College in the Regional Final for the right to advance to the national tournament. MATC fell to the eventual Division III national champions but finished with a stellar 33-6 record. Kristin Brochtrup and Kara Hilmanoski became the first two volleyball All-Americans in school history.

The MATC Golf team overcame a nine stroke first day deficit to win the NJCAA Region XIII title by eight strokes. This was the program's fourth region championship in

school history and its first since 2003. MATC golfers, Josh Pantel, Paul Jacobsen, Eric Isberner, Bryan Leschensky and Ben Steeger qualified for the NJCAA National Golf Tournament on June 5-8, 2007, in Chautauqua, NY.

The MATC Soccer team, ranked #15 in the nation, also claimed the Region XIII title with a 2-1 win. The region title was the second straight and the seventh in program history. With the win, MATC advanced to the District Tournament in Dallas, TX. The WolfPack advanced to the District Final against Richland College but lost to the eventual national champions.



MATC HOSTING WJCAA STATE BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

MATC is proud to host the 2007 WJCAA State Basketball Tournament at the H. Douglas Redsten Gymnasium on Saturday and Sunday, February 24-25. MATC has hosted the event for the past four years. The tournament features the top four junior college men's and women's basketball teams from across the state of Wisconsin. On Saturday, four semifinal games will take place with the

women's semifinal games at 1:00 and 3:00 and the men's semifinal games at 6:00 and 8:00. Ticket prices are as follows: Adults - \$6.00, Students - \$4.00, Children Under 10 are FREE.
